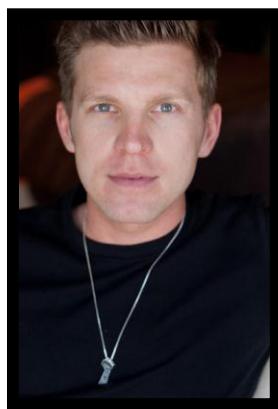
The Young Professionals Society is dedicated to cultivating young, vibrant, professionals in the community by providing networking, professional development and volunteer opportunities.

# Signature Events



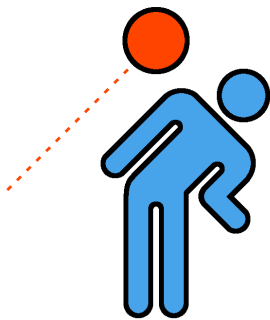
## ***Go Big or Go Home: Entrepreneurs Forum***
